

HEALTH PROMOTION CAMPAIGNS:

Adult health maintenance exam and preventive screenings

Preventive care is one of the most important ways to improve individual health and control rising health care costs. Health care costs can be controlled by shifting spending from high-cost disease treatment to low-cost early detection or intervention. All MESSA health plans cover health maintenance exams, specific preventive screenings and recommended immunizations at 100% — not subject to deductible — when performed by in-network providers.

HELPFUL TIPS TO GET STARTED:

- Define the goal of the campaign.
- Choose activities to incorporate into the campaign.
- Identify resources to successfully execute your campaign. What resources do you have?
 What additional resources do you need?
- Communicate with your members to get them involved.
- Create a campaign calendar containing information release dates and planned activity dates.
- Evaluate your efforts through surveys and measurements indicated on next year's wellness report card.

CAMPAIGN GOALS:

- Educate members about coverage for annual exams and preventive care.
- Educate members about importance of routine preventive care.
- Increase number of members getting an annual exam
- Increase use of free preventive health benefits: annual exam, screenings, immunizations, etc.

 - Display posters in prominent staff areas
